We empower children, schools and communities in Arusha through education, access to long-term opportunity, led by local partnerships and powered by a global community.

We strongly believe in sustainable development and ensure that our operation model is "for the community, by the community".

INUKA'S 2026 IMPACT TARGET: \$100,000

In 2026, Inuka aims to raise \$100,000 across multiple fundraising initiatives, including The Inuka Open.

Funds will support:

- 3 Safe Water Installations
- 1 Period Dignity Block
- Launch of the School-to-School Program
- Continued support of existing initiatives

Why now?

2026 represents a significant expansion year for Inuka as demand increases across our partner schools in Tanzania.



The Inuka Open plays a key role in contributing to this annual goal and supporting these projects.

* Safe Water in Schools

Access to safe, clean drinking water improves health, school attendance and long-term learning outcomes.

Your support helps fund sustainable water systems in Tanzanian schools.

* Period Equity

Creating a clean and safe space where girls can feel comfortable to change, rest and access sanitary items will ensure girls can attend school with dignity and confidence.

Your support helps fight Period Poverty, break stigma and keep girls in classrooms.

* School to School Program

Building partnerships between Australian and Tanzanian schools to share resources, learning opportunities and global connection.

Your support creates long-term educational collaboration, a sense of global citizenship and for students to be a part of something bigger than themselves.



THE 2025 INUKA OPEN SNAPSHOT

This was the first time Inuka had ever put on a corporate style event, and we were blown away with the positive feedback and support to have this fundraising initiative become an annual event.

In 2025 we:

- Successfully launched inaugural corporate-style event
- Established foundational partnerships
- Received strong feedback and demand for expansion in 2026
- Sold over 400 raffle tickets
- Raised \$4,000, covering 75% of funds required to launch the initial sports field project.

And as a result:

- 700 students now have access to a sports field in a safe area to play, learn and thrive
